This note is to thank the congregation for their gracious contributions to the Benevolent Fund during 2025.

As a result, beginning in January, 2026, the Fund has attained its highest starting amount (about \$5,500) in the past five years. That is largely sufficient to help cover the needs for 2026. While I do not want to dissuade anyone from continuing to contribute to the Benevolent Fund as the Lord leads them, I recommend that you consider donating instead to the Operating budget, through your regular envelope givings. Parkwood already has a significant deficit in this going into 2026 and it would be wonderful if your donations to the Operating budget could greatly reduce or eliminate the deficit by the end of 2026.

Again, a heartfelt thank you for all your support in 2025. The gift cards (food vouchers) and white gifts (at Christmas), helped, and will continue to help, many people within and outside our congregation throughout 2026.

Good News

Both the primary and secondary loans can now be completely repaid. These loans were obtained to help finance the renovation and expansion of our current building.

Early in January, Parkwood received an anonymous gift-in-kind (sale of financial stocks) donation of \$26,437 directed to the Loan Repayment Fund. This donation together with the small reserve in the fund as of the end of 2025 means the two loans can be completely repaid. (The outstanding principal for the two loans as of the end of 2025 was \$27,189).

Those members and adherents who have been donating to the repayment of the loans are encouraged to shift their donations to local purposes to help Parkwood meet its daily operating and program costs.
